I refer to the above details. An appeal has been made to the Secretary of State against the decision of Solihull Council Planning Authority to refuse to grant planning permission.

The appeal will be determined on the basis of an **inquiry**. The procedure to be followed is set out in the Town and Country Planning Appeals (Determination by Inspectors) (Inquiries Procedure) (England) Rules 2000.



The Planning Inspectorate has now appointed an Inspector to hold an Inquiry into the appeal and this will open at 9am on 4th September 2014 at the Renewal Conference Centre, Lode Lane, Solihull B91 2JR. The Inquiry is expected to last up to six days (4th, 5th, 9th, 11th, and 12th September at the Renewal Centre, and also 10th September at The Council Chamber, Council House, Civic Suite, Solihull B91 3QB).

Interested parties may attend or be represented at the Inquiry and, at the Inspector's discretion, give their views orally. Even if you do not wish to give any views orally, you may still attend the Inquiry and listen to the proceedings. People with physical or sensory disabilities who have an interest in the appeal and would like to attend the Inquiry may wish to contact the officer at the head of this letter to discuss any special provisions that may need to be in place.

All documents and plans relating to the appeal may be inspected at Solihull Connect, located off Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours.
