



1 Timber play kit will be used for toddlers and juniors within the natural play space



2 The natural play space will be accessed via a gravel pathway and incorporate features such as boulders to define space



3 Fruit trees will be planted at the boundaries of the open space for increased nectar value and foraging habitat



4 Features such as nest swings will be incorporated within the trim trail



5 Wet meadows will be created within the attenuation ponds



6 Aquatic and emergent planting will be used within new areas of permanent water



7 Existing hedgerows and associated ditch courses will be brought under effective management



8 Footpaths will be mown into area of species rich meadow grassland



10 Simple timber benches will be used within the open space



9 The trim trail will include equipment with more of a fitness theme
