Ward Councillor Briefing Paper: Electric Vehicle Charging Point Installation. 6 February 2020

- SMBC officers are currently managing two projects related to electric vehicle charging infrastructure, targeting installations at 23 provisionally identified sites by summer 2020, with a further 25 potential sites identified for future installation.
- On-street Residential Charging Scheme (ORCS)
 - SMBC have applied for grant funding to central government under the ORCS fund in order to install charging points at 17 provisionally identified sites throughout the borough. Locations are provided at **Appendix A**. All sites have been identified in consultation with Highways Services. Site selection criteria are provided within Appendix A.
 - ORCS provides 75% of capital costs, which is projected to total £93,000. The remaining 25%, projected to be £31,000, will be provided for by SMBC. This approach provides SMBC maximum control of both charge point location and energy pricing, as well as providing SMBC with a future revenue stream as electric vehicle uptake increases. All elements of the chargepoints and underground infrastructure will be owned by SMBC.
 - o Confirmation of grant funding in principle is expected February 2020.
 - SMBC will tender for a charge point installation partner who will deliver all civil works, installation and on-going management and maintenance

Virgin

- Virgin Media have grant funding through Innovate UK to trial the installation of electric vehicle chargepoints using power from their roadside cabinet infrastructure
- The project is fully funded, therefore at zero cost to SMBC. Virgin and their private sector consortium will own all elements of the chargepoints and associated underground infrastructure, with a revenue share (still to be determined) to be provided to SMBC.
- o The project will be delivered in two tranches. The first tranche includes six provisionally identified sites, details provided at **Appendix B**. A second tranche is still under first stage review, however sites provided to Virgin are provided at **Appendix C** for reference.
- Site selection criteria are in line with that of ORCS, provided within Appendix A.

Installation

- Installation at all provisionally identified charge point locations will be subject to lead member, ward councillor and resident support, as well as confirmation of feasibility from Western Power Distribution (WPD), with whom initial engagement has been made but detailed site surveys are yet to take place, therefore exact locations may be subject to change.
- o In addition, installation of Virgin sites is subject to SMBC officers being content with contractual terms offered, currently subject to negotiation.
- Residents within the vicinity of all proposed sites will be engaged with and formally consulted through a Traffic Regulations Order.

Existing charge point infrastructure

 Through the ORCS tender it is intended that the nine chargepoints installed under the Cenex project within North Solihull will be re-commissioned and made available for use.
